## SELF-SERVICE PASSWORD RESET: HOW TO CHANGE YOUR SECURITY QUESTIONS

#### How to delete your previously selected security questions

- 1. Launch your web browser (e.g., Chrome, Explorer, Safari) and go to https://aka.ms/ssprsetup
- 2. Log in with your VCH, PHSA or PHC email and password.
- 3. Once logged in successfully, you will see an Approve Sign in request screen.
- 4. Using your MFA-registered mobile device, **accept the prompt or open the Microsoft Authenticator app** and enter the six digit one-time password code.
- 5. On your browser, go to the **Security info** tab and click on the **Delete** beside the Security Questions row. Click **OK** to confirm deletion. *This will delete all five of your previously selected questions.*

- 2. From the Add a method pop-up, choose Security questions from the drop-down options. Click Add.
  - 3. Select one of the 18 questions from the drop-down list and provide your answer.

#### You will need to complete five different questions, answers are not case sensitive

Recommendation: Pick questions that only you know the answer to, preferably single word answers for ease of recall.

A green confirmation message will be displayed to indicate that you have successfully added your selected security questions. You have now completed your Self-Service Password Reset security questions setup and may close your web browser.
